COURSES OFFERED:

Christian Workers (1 Year / 1 Credit Hours): An exciting introduction to the study of the Word and entry level course for the Student entering Bible Institute. Serves as foundation course for other advanced courses. Includes cursory introduction to Homiletics. **Pre-requisites:** None. *(Can be taken along with Evangelism)*

Evangelism (1 Year / 1 Credit Hours): Course designed for all believers from the new convert to the experienced believer, exploring the focus of our Faith and sharing with others. Serves as foundation course for other advanced courses. **Pre-requisites:** None. *(Can be taken along with Christian Workers. Generally taken as 2nd year course after Christian Workers)*

General Bible I (1 Year / 2 Credit Hours): A powerful survey of the Bible as the only rule of the Faith and Practice of the Believer. This course is one of the highlights of the years of study for the Bible School Student, considered the first year of a two-year course track. For 2nd or 3rd year students. Includes more advanced review of Homiletics. **Pre-requisites:** Christian Workers and Evangelism. *(Waiver of Pre-requisites can only come by approval of the Dean with a review of Student prior training and experience)*

General Bible II (1 Year / 2 Credit Hours): The next level of walking through the Bible, essential learning for maturing Christian disciples. This course is one of the highlights of the years of study for the Bible School Student, considered the second year of a two-year course track. For 3rd or 4th year students. **Pre-requisites:** General Bible I. *(Waiver of Pre-requisites can only come by approval of the Dean with a review of Student prior training and experience)*

Post Grad (2 Years / 2 Credit Hours): Split into Parts 1 and 2, this is for the advanced student who has completed all of the pre-requisites and other coursework. This course is writing intensive and includes a required Thesis. Generally considered for 4th or 5th year students. Includes advanced doctrinal review of topics such as Eschatology. **Pre-requisites:** General Bible I and II. *(No Waiver of Pre-requisites for this course)*

Book of Genesis (1 Year / 1 Credit Hours): In-depth survey and Chapter by Chapter walk through this key Old Testament Pentateuch Book. **Pre-requisites:** Christian Workers or Waiver *(Waiver of Pre-requisites can only come by approval of the Dean with a review of Student prior training and experience)*

Book of Job (1 Year / 1 Credit Hours): In-depth survey and Chapter by Chapter walk through this key Old Testament Book. **Pre-requisites:** Christian Workers or Waiver *(Waiver of Pre-requisites can only come by approval of the Dean with a review of Student prior training and experience)*

Apologetics (1 Credit Hours): Apologetics is the religious discipline of defending religious doctrines through systematic argumentation and discourse. In this course students will learn the key elements of

not only defense of the Faith but advancement of the Faith. **Pre-requisites:** Christian Workers and Evangelism (*Waiver of Pre-requisites can only come by approval of the Dean with a review of Student prior training and experience*)
